

TEST DAY INFORMATION

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The test day of the 40th Rallye Sierra Morena Internacional Córdoba Patrimonio de la Humanidad "Trofeo Andalucía Región Europea del Deporte" will take place on Wednesday 15th March 2023. This test will take place in Villanueva del Rey on the road CO-5401, with a length of 4.79 km and will be held from 10:00 to 19:00 hours.

Teams may register for a half day, from 10:00 to 14:30 in the morning or from 14:30 to 19:00 in the afternoon, or for a full day (morning and afternoon). The timetable for collecting documentation will be from 09:00 to 10:00 for those participating in the full day or half day in the morning and from 13:30 to 14:30 for those participating in the half day in the afternoon.

The teams participating in the tests must be in possession of the corresponding licences and all the equipment (overalls, helmet, hans, etc...) required by current regulations, as well as the vehicles must be in perfect condition with regard to the stipulated safety measures (seats, harnesses, extinguishers systems, etc...).

The road has similar characteristics to those used for the rallye, asphalt in good condition, narrow, fast areas on slopes with some hard braking and with gentle climbs and descents. There are no areas where the road can get dirty and no unprotected gullies. At the start of the special stage there will be a safety team consisting of 1 SVA ambulance, 1 SVB ambulance, 1 fire extinguishing and rescue vehicle and 1 crane. There will also be a special stage manager and his deputy at the finish line, as well as 4 intermediate stations and enough marshals to ensure the smooth and safe running of the day.

The test day will follow a similar format to the Shakedown, returning to the start of the rally via a liaison route after the end of the stage. The organisers will provide by email a road-book with the route of the liaison. On the day of the rally it will be timed and the times will be available on the website www.fotomotor.es. The organisers will establish an internal list of registered riders in which a number will be assigned to each participating team for subsequent monitoring. At the documentation collection, participants will be given a set of orange numbers to be fixed to the front windscreen and the rear window of the race vehicle.

Whenever a vehicle suffers a breakdown or an incident on the special stage, the special stage leader will stop the race to remove the vehicle to allow time for repairs.

There is a distance of approximately 1 km from the start of the service car park to the start of the special stage. Although this distance will be closed to traffic, caution is urged when warming up tyres and brakes. The distance from the end of the section to the service park via the liaison route is 21.2 km.

Procedure for reconnaissance the special stage:

1. This must be done before 09:45 in the morning. The road will be closed to traffic from 09:00 hours. To facilitate access to the special stage, participants will be given a sticker to place on their front windscreen in order to pass the road closure.
2. For safety reasons, it is recommended NOT to drive against the current during the reconnaissance.
3. Competitors who cannot be reconnaissance before 09:45 hours (e.g. mid-afternoon competitors) may take advantage of their first passage through the special stage to do so, advising the special stage leader at the start not to release the next competitor for safety reasons until they have reached the finish line.




Collection documents: N38°11'45" W5°08'58"
